The IEPA provides federal funding assistance for public wastewater projects through the Water Pollution Control Loan Program (WPCLP). To qualify, applicants must be a unit of local government (i.e., city, village, or sanitary district, etc.) planning one of the following types of projects: a new wastewater collection and treatment facility or upgrade/expansion of an existing facility; replacement, rehabilitation, or extension of existing wastewater collection systems and interceptors; or separation of combined sewer systems, or upgrade of a combined system, to eliminate overflows, surcharging, or flooding.
